# Electricity Demand in May 2005 (Bulletin)

### [Demand Overview (Total Across the 10 Power Companies)]

Total demand in May was up 0.5% to 65.1 billion kWh across the 10 companies.

Lighting demand rose by 2.4%, a relatively modest figure in comparison to the increases posted over the last three months. Commercial demand increased by 0.8%.

#### (Reference) Large Industrial Demand

Large industrial user demand in May was down for the first time in three months, decreasing by 0.8%. The decline was due to sluggish performance in the chemical, ceramics, and steel sectors, coupled with only slight increases in other sectors.
