Total demand in the first half of 2005 was up 0.1% to 438.4 billion kWh across the 10 companies.

Although the marked difference between last year's record-setting high summer temperatures and this year's comparatively low summer temperatures caused summer cooling demand figures to decline, this was more than offset by strong cooling and heating demand in the spring and fall.
