

## Electricity Demand in Fiscal 2005 (Bulletin)

### [Demand Overview (Total Across the 10 Power Companies)]

Total demand in FY2005 was up for the second consecutive year, rising by 2.0% on last year to 882.6 billion kWh across the ten companies.

Commercial and lighting demand posted increases of 2.3% and 3.2%, respectively. The increase in lighting demand was due to increased demand for heating caused by record low winter temperatures.
