### **Electricity Demand in May 2009 (Confirmed Report)**

### **Demand Overview (Total Sales of 10 Power Companies)**

Electricity demand in May 2009, measured in terms of the total electricity sales of the 10 power companies, was down 8.6% from the last year to 64.5 billion kWh.

- Lighting Demand (down 1.6% on the year, 21.50 billion kWh in total)
- Commercial Demand (down 0.4% on the year, 15.01 billion kWh in total)

Outside the liberalized segment, lighting demand declined by 1.6% due principally to a shorter meterreading period than the last year.

Commercial demand in the liberalized segment decreased by 0.4%.

#### (Reference)

- Large Industrial Demand (down 19.4% on the year, 19.98 billion kWh in total)

Large industrial demand was down year on year for eight consecutive months, decreasing by 19.4%. This was due mainly to year-on-year decline in all major sectors including steel.
