# **Electricity Demand in June 2009 (Bulletin)**

#### **Demand Overview (Total Sales of 10 Power Companies)**

- Electricity demand in June 2009, measured in terms of the total electricity sales of the 10 power companies, was down 7.9% from the last year to 64.4 billion kWh.
- Outside the liberalized segment, lighting demand declined by 2.1% due principally to a shorter meter-reading period than the last year.

Commercial demand in the liberalized segment increased by 0.7%.
