Demand Overview (Total Sales of 10 Power Companies)

Demand Change by Use

- Electricity demand in December, measured in terms of the total electricity sales of the 10 power companies, was down 5.9% on last year to 70.8 billion kWh.

- Outside the liberalized segment, lighting demand declined by 3.0% due principally to a combination of a shorter meter-reading period than the last year, and decreased demand for heating caused by generally higher temperatures from early to mid December compared with the last year.

Commercial demand in the liberalized segment increased by 0.9%.

Lighting Demand (down 3.0% on the year, 24.03 billion kWh in total) Commercial Demand (up 0.9% on the year, 16.03 billion kWh in total)

(Reference) Large Industrial Demand (down 13.0% on the year, 21.55 billion kWh in total)

Large industrial user demand was down year on year for three consecutive months, decreasing by 13.0%. This was due mainly to year-on-year decline in all major sectors including machinery.
