Electricity Demand in August 2009 (Bulletin)

Demand Overview (Total Sales of 10 Power Companies)

- Electricity demand in August 2009, measured in terms of the total electricity sales of the 10 power companies, was down 10.8% from the last year to 77.8 billion kWh.
- Outside the liberalized segment, lighting demand declined by 10.2% due principally to a shorter meter-reading period than the last year, in addition to decreased cooling demand resulted from lower temperatures from July to mid August, compared with a year ago.

Commercial demand in the liberalized segment decreased by 5.4%.
