Electricity Demand in August 2009 (Confirmed Report)

Demand Overview (Total Sales of 10 Power Companies)

- Electricity demand in August, measured in terms of the total electricity sales of the 10 power companies, was down 10.8% on last year to 77.8 billion kWh.
- Outside the liberalized segment, lighting demand declined by 10.2% due principally to a shorter meter-reading period than the last year, in addition to decreased cooling demand resulted from lower temperature from July to mid August, compared with a year before.

Commercial demand in the liberalized segment decreased by 5.4%.

Large Industrial Demand (down 14.1% on the year, 22.10 billion kWh in total)

Large industrial user demand was down year on year for eleventh consecutive months, decreasing by 14.1%.

This was due mainly to year-on-year decline in all major sectors including steel.
