### **Electricity Demand in September 2009 (Confirmed Report)**

#### **Demand Overview (Total Sales of 10 Power Companies)**

- Electricity demand in September, measured in terms of the total electricity sales of the 10 power companies, was down 6.8% on last year to 73.8 billion kWh.
- Outside the liberalized segment, lighting demand declined by 1.8% due principally to decreased cooling demand caused by lower temperatures from early- to mid-September, compared with a year ago, in spite of a longer meter-reading period than the last year.

Commercial demand in the liberalized segment decreased by 3.5%.

Large Industrial Demand (down 13.7% on the year, 22.54 billion kWh in total)

Large industrial user demand was down year on year for twelve consecutive months, decreasing by 13.7%.

This was due mainly to the year-on-year decline in all major sectors including steel.
