Electricity Demand in November 2009 (Bulletin)

Demand Overview (Total Sales of 10 Power Companies)

- Electricity demand in November 2009, measured in terms of the total electricity sales of the 10 power companies, was down 3.5% from the last year to 67.3 billion kWh.
- Outside the liberalized segment, lighting demand declined by 0.5% due principally to a shorter meter-reading period than the last year.

Commercial demand in the liberalized segment decreased by 1.9%.
