Electricity Demand in December 2009 (Bulletin)

Demand Overview (Total Sales of 10 Power Companies)

- Electricity demand in December 2009, measured in terms of the total electricity sales of the 10 power companies, was down 0.4% from the last year to 70.5 billion kWh.
- Outside the liberalized segment, lighting demand declined by 0.9% due principally to a decreased heating demand caused by relatively higher temperatures from late November to early December than a year ago.

Commercial demand in the liberalized segment decreased by 0.9%.
