## **Electricity Demand in April 2010 (Confirmed Report)**

#### **Demand Overview (Total Sales of 10 Power Companies)**

- Electricity demand in April, measured in terms of the total electricity sales of the 10 power companies, was up 8.5% on last year to 74.2 billion kWh.
- Outside the liberalized segment, lighting demand rose by 8.4% year on year due principally to increased heating demand caused by relatively lower temperatures from mid March to April, compared with a year ago, in addition to a longer meter-reading period than the last year.

Commercial demand in the liberalized segment increased by 1.0%.

Large Industrial Demand (up 15.2% on the year, 22.29 billion kWh in total)

Large industrial user demand was up year on year for five consecutive months, increasing by 15.2%. This was due mainly to the year-on-year increase in all major sectors including steel.
