Electricity Demand in June 2010 (Bulletin)

Demand Overview (Total Sales of 10 Power Companies)

- Electricity demand in June 2010, measured in terms of the total electricity sales of the 10 power companies, was up 5.0% from the last year to 67.6 billion kWh.
- Outside the liberalized segment, lighting demand rose by 2.4% due principally to increased cooling demand caused by relatively higher temperatures from mid to late June, compared with a year ago.

Commercial demand in the liberalized segment declined by 0.7%.
