Electricity Demand in August 2010 (Confirmed Report)

Demand Overview (Total Sales of 10 Power Companies)

- Electricity demand in August, measured in terms of the total electricity sales of the 10 power companies, was up 9.2% on last year to 84.9 billion kWh.
- Outside the liberalized segment, lighting demand rose by 9.5% year on year due principally to increased cooling demand caused by unusually high temperatures this summer, in spite of a shorter meter-reading period than the last year.

Commercial demand in the liberalized segment increased by 6.2%.

Large Industrial Demand (up 11.6% on the year, 24.67 billion kWh in total)

Large industrial user demand was up year on year for nine consecutive months, increasing by 11.6%. This was due mainly to the year-on-year increase in all major sectors including machinery.
