Electricity Demand in January 2011 (Bulletin)

Demand Overview (Total Sales of 10 Power Companies)

- Electricity demand in January 2011, measured in terms of the total electricity sales of ten power companies, was up 3.0% from the last year to 83.8 billion kWh.
- Outside the liberalized segment, lighting demand rose by 3.5% due principally to increased hating demand caused by relatively lower temperatures in January compared with a year ago.

Commercial demand in the liberalized segment declined by 0.1%.
