# Electricity Demand in the FY2010 (Bulletin)

## Demand Overview (Total Sales of 10 Power Companies)

#### (Reference)

- Electricity demand in fiscal 2010, measured in terms of the total electricity sales of the 10 power utilities, was up for the first time in three years, increasing by 5.6% from the last year to 90.64 billion kWh.

- Outside the liberalized segment, lighting demand rose by 6.8% due principally to increased demand for cooling caused by record high temperatures in this summer.

Commercial demand in the liberalized segment increased by 1.8%.

# Large industrial demand was up year on year for the first time in three years, increasing by 7.5%. This was due mainly to year-on-year increase in all major sectors including steel.
