Electricity Demand in the Second Half of Fiscal 2010 (Confirmed Report)

Demand Overview (Total Sales of 10 Power Companies)

Electricity demand in the second half of fiscal 2010, measured in terms of the total electricity sales of the ten power companies, was up for three consecutive half terms, increasing by 2.5% from the last year to 448.2 billion kWh.

- Lighting Demand (up 3.7% on the year, 158.08 billion kWh in total)
- Commercial Demand (down 0.1% on the year, 97.42 billion kWh in total)

Outside the liberalized segment, lighting demand rose by 3.7% due principally to increased demand for heating caused by generally lower temperatures this winter compared with the last year. Commercial demand in the liberalized segment declined by 0.1%.

- Large Industrial Demand (up 3.2% on the year, 136.58 billion kWh in total)

Large industrial demand was up for three consecutive half terms, increasing by 3.2%. This was due mainly to year-on-year increase in all major sectors including steel.
