Electricity Demand in April 2011 (Bulletin)

Demand Overview (Total Sales of 10 Power Companies)

- Electricity demand in April 2011, measured in terms of the total electricity sales of ten power companies, was down year on year, decreasing by 6.5% to 69.3 billion kWh, due mainly to the impact of the Great East Japan Earthquake.
- -Outside the liberalized segment, lighting demand declined by 4.4% due principally to the impact of the Great East Japan Earthquake.

Commercial demand in the liberalized segment declined by 10.8%, due mainly to the effect of the Great East Japan Earthquake.

Large industrial demand was down year on year for two consecutive months, decreasing by 6.2%. This was mainly due to a year-on-year decrease in paper & pulp, chemicals, non-ferrous metals and machinery, due primarily to the effect of the Great East Japan Earthquake.
