Electricity Demand in May 2011 (Confirmed Report)

Demand Overview (Total Sales of 10 Power Companies)

- Electricity demand in May 2011, measured in terms of the total electricity sales of ten power companies, was down year on year for three consecutive months, decreasing by 6.5% to 64.37 billion kWh, due mainly to the impact of the Great East Japan Earthquake.
- Outside the liberalized segment, lighting demand declined by 7.1% year on year due principally to the effect of the Great East Japan Earthquake.

Commercial demand in the liberalized segment dropped by 10.2%, due mainly to the effect of the Great East Japan Earthquake.

Lighting Demand (down 7.1% on the year, 21.28 billion kWh in total)
Commercial Demand (down 10.2% on the year, 13.50 billion kWh in total)

Large Industrial Demand (down 3.3% on the year, 21.71 billion kWh in total)

Large industrial user demand was down year on year for three consecutive months, decreasing by 3.3%.

This was due mainly to the year-on-year decrease in major industries except for chemicals, and ceramics, due mainly to the effect of Great East Japan Earthquake.
