Electricity Demand in the First Half of Fiscal 2011 (Confirmed Report)

Demand Overview (Total Sales of 10 Power Companies)

Electricity demand in the first half of fiscal 2011, measured in terms of the total electricity sales of the ten power companies, was down for the first time in four half terms, decreasing by 7.9% from the last year to 422.2 billion kWh.

Outside the liberalized segment, lighting demand declined by 8.1% due principally to the effects of the Great East Japan Earthquake and to the efforts for saving electricity, in addition to decreased demand for cooling caused by generally lower temperatures this summer compared with the last

Commercial demand in the liberalized segment also dropped by 11.8%.

- Lighting Demand (down 8.1% on the year, 134.29 billion kWh in total)
- Commercial Demand (down 11.8% on the year, 95.20 billion kWh in total)

- Large Industrial Demand (down 4.7% on the year, 137.00 billion kWh in total)

Large industrial demand was down for the first time in four half terms, decreasing by 4.7%. This was due mainly to year-on-year decrease in all major sectors except for ceramics, being affected by the Great East Japan Earthquake and the efforts for saving electricity.
