Electricity Demand in October 2011 (Bulletin)

Demand Overview (Total Sales of 10 Power Companies)

- Electricity demand in October 2011, measured in terms of the total electricity sales of ten power companies, was down year on year, decreasing by 6.3% to 66.9 billion kWh.
- Outside the liberalized segment, lighting demand decreased by 6.7%, due principally to the increased energy-saving awareness among customers.

Commercial demand in the liberalized segment also declined by 10.7%.
