Electricity Demand in May 2012 (Bulletin)

Demand Overview (Total Sales of 10 Power Companies)

- Electricity demand in May 2012, measured in terms of the total electricity sales of the ten power companies, was up year on year, increasing by 1.8% to 65.5 billion kWh.
- Outside the liberalized segment, lighting demand remained approximately the same as last year, increasing by 0.0%.

Commercial demand in the liberalized segment increased by 4.0% due mainly to a rebound from the negative effect of the Great East Japan Earthquake.

Large industrial demand grew year on year for the third consecutive month, increasing by 2.0%. This was mainly due to a year-on-year increase in major industries except for textiles, paper & pulp and chemicals, due principally to a rebound from the negative effect of the Great East Japan Earthquake.
