Electricity Demand in September 2012 (Bulletin)

Demand Overview (Total Sales of 10 Power Companies)

- Electricity demand in September 2012, measured in terms of the total electricity sales of the ten power companies, was up year on year, increasing by 0.6% to 76.4 billion kWh.

- Outside the liberalized segment, lighting demand grew by 0.1%, due principally to increased cooling demands caused by relatively higher temperatures from late August to early September than the previous year, in spite of a shorter meter-reading period compared with a year ago.

Commercial demand in the liberalized segment rose by 4.9% due mainly to increased cooling demands caused by relatively higher temperatures from late August to early September than the previous year.
