Electricity Demand in November 2012 (Bulletin)

Demand Overview (Total Sales of 10 Power Companies)

- Electricity demand in November 2012, measured in terms of the total electricity sales of the ten power companies, was down year on year, decreasing by 0.7% to 64.4 billion kWh.

- Outside the liberalized segment, lighting demand grew by 3.4%, due principally to increased heating demands caused by relatively lower temperatures from mid October to November than the previous year, in spite of efforts by customers for saving electricity.

Commercial demand in the liberalized segment rose by 0.5% due mainly to increased heating demands caused by relatively lower temperatures from mid October to November than the previous year, in spite of efforts by customers for saving electricity,.
