Electricity Demand in July 2013 (Bulletin)

Demand Overview (Total Sales of 10 Power Companies)

- Electricity demand in July 2013, measured in terms of the total electricity sales of the ten power companies, was up year on year, increasing by 2.5% to 70.2 billion kWh.
- Outside the liberalized segment, lighting demand grew by 3.2%, due principally to increased cooling demands caused by generally higher temperatures from mid-June to mid-July than the previous year.Commercial demand in the liberalized segment rose by 3.9% due mainly to increased cooling demands caused by generally higher temperatures from early to mid-July than the previous year.
