Electricity Demand in August 2013 (Bulletin)

Demand Overview (Total Sales of 10 Power Companies)

- Electricity demand in August 2013, measured in terms of the total electricity sales of the ten power companies, was up year on year, increasing by 1.2% to 78.5 billion kWh.

- Outside the liberalized segment, lighting demand grew by 3.7%, due principally to increased cooling demands caused by generally higher temperatures from early to mid- August than the previous year, in addition to a longer meter-reading period compared with a year ago.

Commercial demand in the liberalized segment rose by 0.5% due mainly to increased cooling demands caused by generally higher temperatures from early to mid-August than the previous year.
