## **Electricity Demand in the Second Half of Fiscal 2013 (Confirmed Report)**

### Demand Overview (Total Sales of 10 Power Companies)

- -Electricity demand in the second half of fiscal 2013, measured in terms of the total electricity sales of the ten power companies, rose by 0.3% from the last year to 430.4 billion kWh.
- Outside the liberalized segment, lighting demand declined by 0.4% due principally to decreased heating demands caused by relatively higher temperatures from late November to January than last

Commercial demand in the liberalized segment also dropped by 1.3% due mainly to decreased heating demands.

Lighting Demand (down 0.4% on the year, 153.51 billion kWh in total) Commercial Demand (down 1.3% on the year, 91.81 billion kWh in total)

#### (Reference)

Large industrial demand was up for the first time in six half terms, increasing by 2.4%. This was due mainly to year-on-year increase in major sectors except for paper & pulp, ceramic and non-ferrous metals.
