

Electricity Demand in September 2014 (Bulletin)

Demand Overview (Total Sales of 10 Power Companies)

- Electricity demand in September 2014, measured in terms of the total electricity sales of the ten power companies, was down year on year, decreasing by 8.1% to 68.3 billion kWh.

- Outside the liberalized segment, lighting demand dropped by 14.1%, due principally to decreased cooling demands caused by relatively lower temperatures from mid- to late September, in addition to a shorter meter-reading period compared with a year ago.

Commercial demand in the liberalized segment also declined by 8.6%, due mainly to decreased cooling demands.

Large industrial demand dropped year on year for the fifth consecutive month, decreasing by 1.5%.

This was due mainly to a year-on-year decrease in major industries except for chemicals and non-ferrous metals.
