Electricity Demand in February 2015 (Bulletin)

Demand Overview (Total Sales of 10 Power Companies)

- Electricity demand in February 2015, measured in terms of the total electricity sales of the ten power companies, was down year on year, decreasing by 3.0% to 74.2 billion kWh.
- Outside the liberalized segment, lighting demand dropped by 3.0%, due principally to decreased heating demands caused by relatively higher temperatures from January to February than the previous year.

Commercial demand in the liberalized segment also declined by 3.3%, due mainly to decreased heating demands.
