Electricity Demand in November 2015 (Bulletin)

Demand Overview (Total Sales of 10 Power Companies)

- Electricity demand in November 2015, measured in terms of the total electricity sales of the ten power companies, was down year on year, decreasing by 3.8% to 60.7 billion kWh.
- Outside the liberalized segment, lighting demand dropped by 4.1%, due principally to decreased heating demands caused by relatively higher temperatures in mid-November than the previous year, in addition to a generally shorter meter-reading period compared with a year ago.

Commercial demand in the liberalized segment declined by 5.4%.
