Electricity Demand in January 2016 (Bulletin)

Demand Overview (Total Sales of 10 Power Companies)

- Electricity demand in January 2016, measured in terms of the total electricity sales of the ten power companies, was down year on year, decreasing by 8.7% to 73.2 billion kWh.
- Outside the liberalized segment, lighting demand dropped by 11.4%, due principally to decreased heating demands caused by relatively higher temperatures from December to early January than the previous year, in addition to a generally shorter meter-reading period compared with a year ago.

Commercial demand in the liberalized segment declined by 9.5%.
