## Electricity Demand in Second Half of Fiscal 2015 (Bulletin)

## Demand Overview (Total Sales of 10 Power Companies)

- Electricity demand in the second half of fiscal 2015, measured in terms of the total electricity sales of the ten power companies, decreased by 4.3% to 401.2 billion kWh.

- Outside the liberalized segment, lighting demand decreased by 4.1%, due principally to decreased heating demands caused by relatively higher temperatures from December to the early January than last year.

Commercial demand in the liberalized segment deceased by 6.4%.

Large industrial user demand declined year-on-year for the fourth consecutive term, decreasing by 3.0%.

(Reference) Large Industry Demand Volume and Year-on-year Basis by Sector

This was mainly due to a year-on-year decrease in all major industries.
