Electricity Demand in Fiscal 2015 (Bulletin)

Demand Overview (Total Sales of 10 Power Companies)

- Electricity demand in fiscal 2015, measured in terms of the total electricity sales of the ten power companies, was down for the fifth consecutive year, decreasing by 3.2% to 797.1 billion kWh.

- Outside the liberalized segment, lighting demand decreased by 2.3% due principally to decreased cooling demands caused by relatively lower temperatures from June to July, and decreased heating demands caused by relatively higher temperatures from December to January than the previous year

Commercial demand in the liberalized segment deceased by 5.0%.

Large industrial user demand declined year-on-year for the second consecutive year, decreasing by 2.8%.

This was mainly due to a year-on-year decrease in all major industries.
