Electricity Demand in April 2014 (Bulletin)

Demand Overview (Total Sales of 10 Power Companies)

- Electricity demand in April 2014, measured in terms of the total electricity sales of the ten power companies, was up year on year, increasing by 0.5% to 66.4 billion kWh.
- -Outside the liberalized segment, lighting demand rose by 0.6%, due principally to a longer meter-reading period compared with a year ago.

Commercial demand in the liberalized segment declined by 0.5%, due mainly to decreased heating demands caused by generally higher temperatures in April than the previous year.
