# Electricity Demand in the First Half of Fiscal 2014 (Confirmed Report)

#### Demand Overview (Total Sales of 10 Power Companies)

- Electricity demand in the first half of fiscal 2014, measured in terms of the total electricity sales of the ten power companies, dropped by 3.5% from the last year to 403.6 billion kWh.

- Outside the liberalized segment, lighting demand declined by 5.6% due principally to decreased cooling demands caused by relatively lower temperatures from June to September than last year.

Commercial demand in the liberalized segment also dropped by 4.4% due mainly to decreased cooling demands.

Lighting Demand (down 5.6% on the year, 123.46 billion kWh in total) Commercial Demand (down 4.4% on the year, 93.11 billion kWh in total)

#### (Reference)

Large industrial demand was down for the first time in two half terms, increasing by 0.7%. This was due mainly to year-on-year decrease in major sectors except for steel and non-ferrous metals.
