Electricity Demand in December 2014 (Bulletin)

Demand Overview (Total Sales of 10 Power Companies)

- Electricity demand in December 2014, measured in terms of the total electricity sales of the ten power companies, was down year on year, decreasing by 1.3% to 67.9 billion kWh.

- Outside the liberalized segment, lighting demand dropped by 1.5%, due principally to decreased heating demands caused by relatively higher temperatures in late November than the previous year.

Commercial demand in the liberalized segment also declined by 2.0%, due mainly to decreased heating demands.
